Summary & Asturia

General Updates, Recent & Upcoming Maintenance Events

Continue to pick up construction trash and debris as part of maintenance.

Do necessary irrigation repairs in the community.

Install community mulch.

The following are action items for Down to Earth to complete. Please refer to the item # in your response listing action already taken or anticipated time of completion. Red text indicates deficient from previous report. Bold Red text indicates deficient for more than a month. Green text indicates a proposal has been requested. Blue indicates irrigation.

- 1. Weed Liriope bed in the right of way of 8. Treat active fire ant mounds in the community. Promenade at the east entrance to the community.
- 2. Prune Podocarpus at the east entrance monument bed on Promenade.
- 3. Remove sucker growth from Crape Myrtles in the right of way of Promenade east end.
- 4. Weed Jasmine Minima in the monument plant bed at the east end of Promenade.
- 5. Plant beds in the community need mulching.
- 6. Weed right of ways along Promenade across from the apartments.
- 7. Weed Jasmine Minima bed in the right of way of Promenade south side.

- 9. Prune Muhly Grass over the curbing in the clubhouse parking lot.(photo 40)
- 10. Cut back Muhly Grass over the sidewalk of the pool entrance of the clubhouse.
- 11. Prune Muhly Grass over the paver sidewalk of the pool area of the clubhouse.
- 12. Make sure crews are blowing debris off of the window ledges of the clubhouse.
- 13. Treat turf weeds next to the sidewalk at the clubhouse entrance.
- 14. Treat turf weeds in front of the workout room of the clubhouse.

- 15. Treat weeds in the Jasmine Minima in the center median of Promenade at the Asturian intersection.
- 16. Treat Knockout Roses for fungus at the Park at the west end of Promenade.
- 17. Remove weeds from the Muhly Grass plant bed on the east side of the clubhouse.
- 18. Treat Dollar Weed in the right of way turf at the intersection of Claymore and Promenade.
- 19. Prune Jasmine Minima at the center median monument at SR 54 and Asturian.



- 20. Weed Jasmine Minima bed in the center median of Asturian.
- 21. Weed Jasmine Minima plant bed in the right of way of Promenade at Asturian. West side.
- 22. Weed Muhly Grass beds at the park on Promenade west end.
- 23. Weed Jasmine Minima plant bed and treat Dollar Weed in the turf at the park on Promenade west end.
- 24. Remove debris from plant beds in the park on Promenade west end.
- 25. Repair irrigation main line break in the park at the end of Trails Edge.



- 26. Give proposal to install missing sod at the park at the intersection of Trails Edge and Long Bow.
- 27. Prune ornamental grasses in the park on Long Bow at Edge Ct.
- 28. Treat weeds in the turf of the park on Long Bow at Trails Edge.
- 29. Give proposal to install missing Podocarpus around the perimeter of the back of the clubhouse. (photo 67)
- 30. Investigate and repair irrigation break in the park on Caravan behind the clubhouse.(photo 69)
